(A) France customers are encouraged to make more environmentally friendly habits under a series of new rules. A law banning plastic packaging for great numbers of fruits and vegetables 24 in France. Starting from New Year's Day, leeks, carrots, potatoes, apples, pears and around 30 other fresh produce will no longer be sold in plastic bags. Some soft
