<1> Have you ever been told that you babble in your sleep, but you don't remember anything? Sleep talking, formally known as somniloquy, is a type of sleep disorder. It's usually harmless, unless you're spilling deep secrets.

About 50 percent of children and five percent of adults talk during sleep. Such late-night talks can be exceptionally eloquent, or the words could be hard to understand. Sleep talkers whisper or shout. They normally speak for more than 30 seconds, but some people sleep talk many times during a night.

Another sleep disorder is somnambulism, or sleepwalking. This is a much more dangerous disorder, as sleepwalkers engage in activities of various types and complexities. They may do something as simple as sit up in bed or wander about the house looking confused. Some people have made phone calls, while others have even been known to get into vehicles and drive away.

Sleepwalking normally takes place early in the night during deep sleep. Sleep walkers aren't easily awakened and usually get back to bed without waking up. If you suddenly wake up sleepwalkers, they might be startled and responded violently. Therefore, if you catch someone out for a nighttime stroll, it's best to talk gently to the person and guide him back to the bed.

The causes of sleep talking and sleepwalking are still unclear. Experts think they are related to brain chemicals. Certain sleeping pills have been known to cause sleepwalking. Stress, fatigue, and lack of sleep are common triggers for sleep disorders.

There's no specific treatment, but you can end your sleep deprivation by improving your "sleep hygiene," which refers to the habits that help you get restful sleep. Stick to regular sleep schedules and avoid food and caffeine before bedtime. Develop a relaxing routine before bed, such as a warm bath or soothing music.

Getting a good rest is important for your health. Remember to always give sleep the attention it deserves.

<3> A high percentage of the garbage that is tossed onto the street ends up in the ocean. Some pieces of trash sink to the ocean floor. Others get eaten by sea creatures, and may kill them. Still others float around on the surface of the water. Due to currents, this floating garbage gets pushed to certain areas of the ocean, where it builds up into larger collections. The largest such collection that we know of, located between Asia and North America, is the Great Pacific Garbage **Patch**.

Some imagine the Great Pacific Garbage Patch as a floating island of trash, but that is not the case. To be more precise, it is an area with a higher concentration of tiny pieces of plastic just beneath the surface. Most pieces are so small that they are impossible to see with the naked eye or using photos captured by satellites. As a result, it is difficult to determine just how large the garbage patch is.

Estimates of the size of the garbage patch depend on what concentration of plastic particles we use to define the affected area. Conservative estimates say that the patch is at least 700,000 km², about twenty times the size of Taiwan, while others say it is at least 15,000,000 km², roughly twice the size of the US.

Efforts have been made to deal with the Great Pacific Garbage Patch ever since its discovery. Scientists are investigating the patch, so we must await further data so that we can

understand its impact on humans and the ocean environment. To raise awareness, some companies are creating products made of recycled ocean plastic. But some say these efforts aren't enough to counter this grave problem.
